**April is a 'special event month' as we host
writers from the Writers Caravan Project**



The Writers Caravan is a pilot project run by Thursdays Writing Collective to foster creative contact among writers who would not come into contact otherwise. TWC holds free, drop-in creative writing courses for people on the Downtown Eastside of Vancouver each Thursday from 2-4pm at the Carnegie Community Centre at Hastings and Main Streets.

During spring 2011 three writing groups from around the city, from different concerns and walks of life, will come write with TWC for one session. One of these groups is made of SFU's 2011 Writer's Studio participants.

After the writing encounter each visiting group hosts a joint reading held in the visitors' area. The TWS participant group is hosting the Caravan reading through the TWS Reading Series. Caravan writers will read their pieces produced during or around the generative encounter.

The Writers Caravan culminates with a celebratory reading with all three groups on June 21, 2011, and a publication guest-edited by Michael Turner to be launched at the Memory Festival in November 2011.
